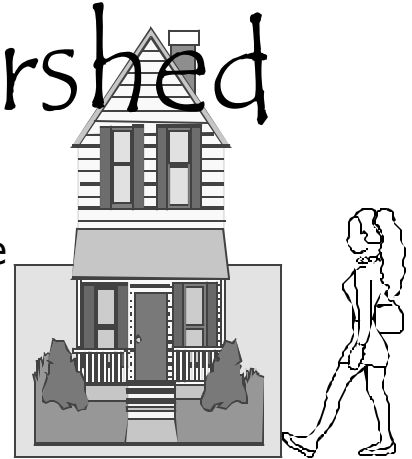


Walk Your Watershed
